This guide lists new features available in **eTapestry** 7.30.0, released on April 23, 2017.

CAPTCHA

Note: This feature only applies to organizations that have enabled CAPTCHA on DIY Forms.

The CAPTCHA field that appears on your DIY forms and Forward to a Friend pages has been updated to protect your forms from spam in a format that is easier to use.

Warning: The original CAPTCHA field will continue to appear on existing DIY forms. This update applies to republished and new forms.

Previously, users were required to type the text displayed in the CAPTCHA images. Now, users only have to select images in order to submit the form or page.

Accounting Exports: MYOB AccountRight 2015 and Later

To meet new import file requirements for the latest version of *MYOB AccountRight*, we have created a standard accounting export that can be used for AccountRight 2015. You will still be able to access the export to be used for AccountRight v19 or earlier from **Standard Exports**.

From **Management**, select **Standard Exports**. The eTapestry Standard Exports page appears. Under **Accounting Exports**, select **MYOB AccountRight 2015**. AddressFinder: NAICS Code and PO Box Check

Due to recent updates to the service, **eTapestry** now has additional requirements to run AddressFinder (NCOA).

NAICS Code Field

To continue successfully processing your AddressFinder (NCOA) service, **eTapestry** has added the **NAICS Code** field to the AddressFinder (NCOA) scheduling page for you to enter your organization's North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code. From **Management**, select **AddressFinder (NCOA)**. On the scheduling page, complete the information needed to schedule your AddressFinder (NCOA) process. For more information about the items on this screen, see [Schedule and run the AddressFinder \(NCOA\) service](#). In the **NAICS Code** field, enter your organization's NAICS code.

NAICS Code *

The service requires a six digit code that identifies the business classification of your organization. For more information, click [here](#).

Once you have completed the information on the scheduling screen, select **Submit** to run the process.

PO Box Check

The address listed for your organization under **Management, My Organization** must be a street address in order to run the AddressFinder (NCOA) service. The service will not run if your organization's address is a PO box, and **eTapestry** will prompt you to change your organization's address to a street address.

My Organization Journal: DIY Forms

To help you track when a user disables or deletes your organization's DIY forms, **eTapestry** now includes notes on the account journal for your organization when those actions occur.
