





Kids can raise money through things like a lemonade stand or donate $\frac{1}{3}$ of their piggy bank on their birthday (our family tradition).

Find volunteer activities kids and families can do together (like pack food at the food bank or Stop Hunger Now)

Children have poignant messages for members of Congress or letters to the editor. Exercise your right to contact elected representatives. Focus on small acts of kindness.

Donate an amount that equals something tangible (Example: \$20 provides weekend meals for a child in need.).

Choose causes based on what interests the child.

Local - What can you do in your school or community?

Region - What are needs in your county or state?

Nation - What are national issues that you might not see and experience but have read about and want to support?

Global - What are children experiencing around the world? How are their needs and experiences the same and different from your own?
